Sub:- Problem in MIS data entry under MGNREGA.

Sir,

I would like to draw your attention to a couple of problems related to MIS in MGNREGA, which, though several communications have been made from this office, remains unsolved.

1) Password for Panchayat Samities and other line departments, acting as PIA:

A few Panchayat Samities and line departments like Forest, Sericulture, Irrigation etc. have been acting as PIA in this district and have already expended above Rs. 1.00 Crore, as on date. However, though application have been made to the State MGNREGA Office, ( vide this office memo no. 2506 dt. 19.11.2010, e-mail dt. 23.11.2010, 07.07.2011, 05.09.2011, 04.01.2012) the passwords for online data entry for these PIAs have not been provided till date, As a result, MIS uploading of Muster-rolls, pertaining to these PIAs have not been possible.

2) Online entry for Bhatar Nirman Rajiv Gandhi Seva Kendra:

In Burdwan, 19 Programme Officers and 7 Gram Panchayats have already been provided administrative approval in the last quarter of financial year 2010-11 for construction of Bharat Nirman Rajiv Gandhi Seva Kendra & accordingly work entry was also made in MIS. The financial allotment of fund and construction work for the Seva Kendra started from July, 2011 onwards. Now, as the account of the financial year 2010-11 has been closed on July, 2011, the online data entry is not possible for these works. This is creating a major problem, as more than Rs. 5.00 Crore has been allotted for this work, but no reflection in MIS is possible - thereby reducing the financial achievement of this district.

This matter has also been communicated to state MGNREGA Cell for solution, but no break through is possible till date over the matter.

I would request you to kindly look into the matter and take necessary step, so that the problems faced above can be resolved at an early date. Thanking You.
